

Farranrory Wind Farm Grid Connection Notice of Road Closure

To all Residents, Local Services & Businesses,

We are writing to inform you of upcoming road works in your area. As representatives of Jones Engineering, the appointed contractor for the construction of the Grid Route to facilitate the utilisation of Wind Power from the 9 Turbine Windfarm under construction in Farranrory, Co. Tipperary to Ballyragget Substation. <https://www.farranrorywindfarm.com/>

The Grid Connection cable route emerges from the windfarm in the townlands of Coolanshinnagh and mostly follows the public road corridor until it reaches the 110kV substation at Ballyragget.

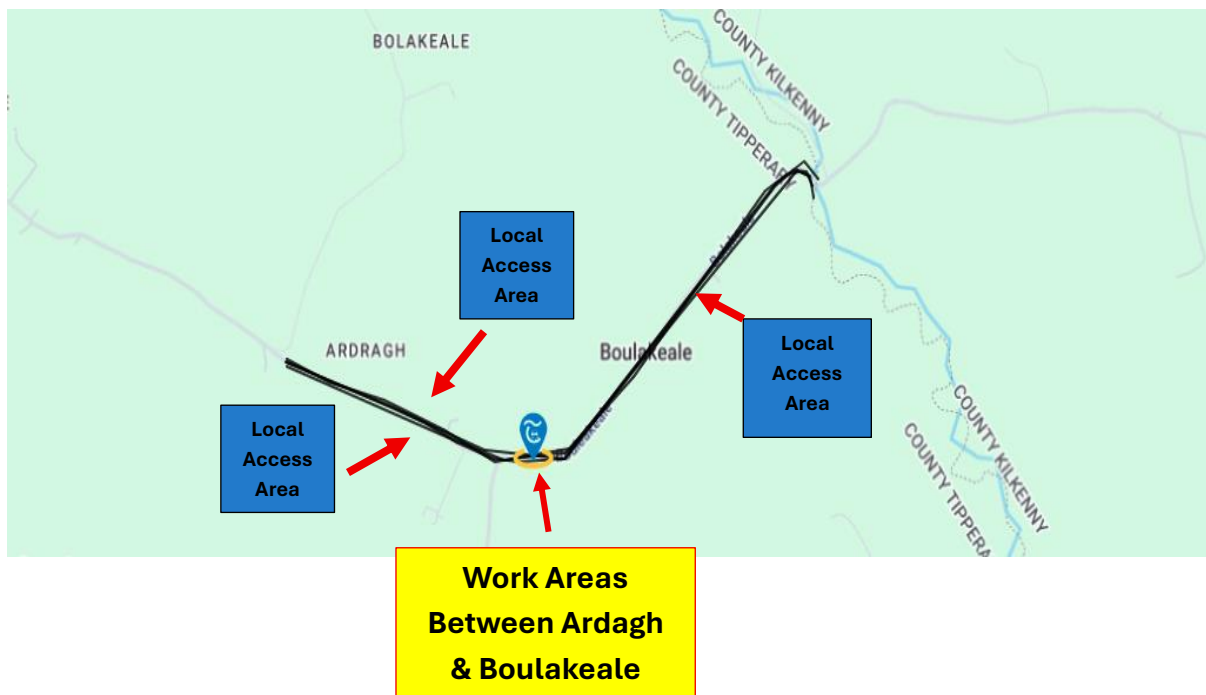
A Road Closure is being put in place to facilitate the Grid Connection works.

We understand this may cause inconvenience and disruptions to your daily travel, but we hope for your understanding and cooperation while this is ongoing.

The following roads will be closed on the dates specified below; diversions will be in place; however, local access will be available. Emergency access will be prioritised.

Road: Ardragh to Boulakeale to the Munster River / Rathmacan New Road

L 5026 from the junction with L 5022 to the junction with L 5027 toward Pollagh for a distance of 1400 m.

Finish Date: 15/10/2025

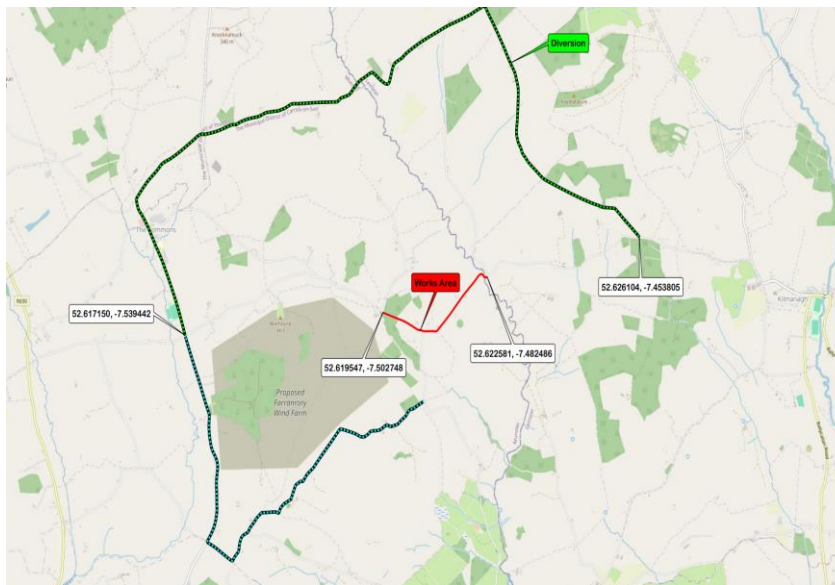

Alternative Routes:

Travelling from Kilmanagh towards The Commons to be diverted right at Killeen onto L-5021 continuing straight to the T – Junction at Boggan. Traffic is to turn left at the T-Junction along the L-1005 to the fork in the road. Traffic is to keep left and travel along the L-2105 to T Junction at Garransilly. Traffic is to turn right onto the L-2106 and then turn left at the crossroads onto L-2107 heading for Garrancool. At the crossroads, traffic to turn left onto the L-6121 and travel to the Farranrory Junction with L-6124. Traffic diversion will operate vice versa.
