Project update

All Turbines Installed at Farranrory Onshore Wind Farm in County Tipperary, Ireland

February 2026

All wind turbines have successfully been installed and pre-commissioned at Farranrory Onshore Wind Farm in Co. Tipperary, Ireland: our 22nd wind farm on the island of Ireland.

Located near Ballingarry, the onshore wind farm consists of nine Nordex N133 4.8 MW turbines and will substantially improve the Irish grid via a 33.5km 110kV connection to Ballyragget substation in Co. Kilkenny.

There is currently approximately 19km of underground ducting installed with cable pulling and jointing works also ongoing.

We would sincerely like to thank those affected by associated Road works during Turbine Delivery phase and ongoing Grid Works for your continued patience.

Once fully operational the wind farm will have capacity to supply 43.2 MW of renewable electricity, which is enough to power up to 25,000 households.

The development was awarded a contract under the Irish Government's third onshore Renewable Electricity Support Scheme (RESS 3) auction in 2023 and is expected to be fully operational by Q3 of 2026.

Farranrory Wind Farm will have a community benefit fund of over €250,000 per annum. Once operational, this funding will be distributed to organisations in the local area through

an open application process. Any not-for-profit organisation within 10km of the wind farm will be able to apply for funding to support the economic, environmental, and social wellbeing of the community. A committee made up of local volunteers will act as the decision-making body for this fund. The selection process will be a public process advertised across local radio and news outlets. We will begin accepting applications for the committee in Q2 of 2026.

A portion of the Community Benefit Fund will also be used for near neighbour payments. If you live within 1km of the wind farm, you may be entitled to such payments. The An Post geo-directory is used to measure the distance from the base of any turbine to nearby households. We recommend you contact us if you believe you are eligible for payments.
